Abstracts reflecting new and innovative information in any area of public health disproportionately impacting members of the African diaspora will be reviewed, example topics include but are not limited to:

- 250 words or less and should include: Purpose/Objective, Methods, Results and Conclusion
- Abstract submissions should include author names, affiliations and should indicate whether or not it is a student submission

- Authors will be notified of decision by Friday, September 21, 2018

\*All abstracts will be peer-reviewed, evaluated, and ranked for originality, quality, topic applicability, and relation to the mission of SAAPHI.
